Guidelines for receiving of samples in Pathology & Biochemistry Department

In order to avoid sampling error, it has been decided that following SOPs must be followed during collection and sending the samples:

- All requisition forms for any investigation should be completely filled in all respect and signed & stamped by concerned doctor and cross checked by the person who is sending it.
- 2. All the requisition forms should have correct C.R No, OPD Registration no.
- 3. All the sample vials & containers should be labelled with Name, C.R. No. and the type of sample & Name of the test prescribed and should match with the details on the requisition forms with full signature, Name and Stamp of the Doctor, as well as Name of Unit I/C.
- 4. For Histopathology / Cytopathology (FNAC etc) requisition forms should be complete with history of the patient, name, CR No., Dr Name, Unit I/C, stamp of referring doctor. The container should also be labelled with complete patient details. NO CUTTING / overwriting is permitted & such cases, sample will be returned back.
- 5. In case of CBC Sample / HBA1C / HPLC for Thalassemia, if sample found clotted or having micro clots, sample will not be given back & only requisition slip mentioning clotted sample will be given back.

In case of HPLC for Thalassemia, History of recent blood transfusion within 3 months is to be mentioned on requisition slip.
