Matter has been examined by the expert Committee who opined that "Evidence for use of Keto-Analogues/Amino Acids in CKD is very weak. KDIGO. (Kidney Disease Improving Global Outcome) guidelines of 2012 also do not recommend the use of Keto-Analogues/Amino Acids in CKD. So the Committee is of the opinion that the use of Keto-Analogues/Amino Acids is not indicated in CKD patients".

In view of above opinion, Keto-Analogues/Amino Acid preparations are not to be indented/issued in CKD patients. Previous Circular No. vide file no. 32-27/07-08/CGHS/MSD/16961 dated 11/11/2009 is no more valid.

"(III) vaccines in general will be admissible, except Hepatitis B, influenza and Leprovac vaccines for high risk individual is recommended by specialist with justification and countersigned by HOD of concerned speciality of Government Hospital."

## The paragraph (iii) may be amended to read as follows:

(iii) vaccines in general, will be inadmissible except Hepatitis B, influenza and Leprovac vaccines for high risk individual is recommended by specialist with justification and countersigned by HOD of concerned speciality of Government Hospital."

There is no change in other paragraphs in the Office Memorandum of 23<sup>rd</sup> July. 2009, referred to above.

Non-admissibility of preparation such as primarily face, to vice cosmetics and vaccines

Undersigned is directed to say that the question of admissibility or otherwise to beneficiaries under CGH5/C5(MA) Rules 1944 of preparations which are primarily food, vitamins, iHaematinic minerals, anti-oxidants, cosmetics and vaccines, has been under consideration for some time. On the recommendations of an Expert Committee and Drug Controller General of India, it has been decided that:

- (i) Product manufactured/marketed as food supplement, cosmetics and ayurvedic preparation prescribed by allopathic doctors will be inadmissible.
- (ii) Supply of vitamins, minerals and anti-oxidants will be restricted to prevalent
- Init vaccines, in general, will be admissible, except Repatitis B. Influents and approved - accioes for high risk individual, is resummended by specialist with the just heating and countersigned by HOD of concerned speciality of Government Heating.

These instructions take effect from the date of issue of the Office Memorandum.
