CIRCULAR

In reference to certain deficiencies noticed during NQAS internal assessment and observations made during routine rounds; requiring prompt corrective action on the part of concerned Senior Nursing Officers in coordination with NABH and Infection control team.

Following measures need to be implemented in the patient care area; ensuring improved safety.

1. Infection Control:

❖ Senior Nursing Officers to ensure:

- ✓ Isolation and barrier nursing procedures are followed for septic cases.
- ✓ Availability of alcohol based hand rubs, antiseptic solutions and disinfectants.
- ✓ Proper handling of soiled and infected linen and that there is no sorting, rinsing or sluicing at patient care area.
- ✓ Proper segregation of clean and dirty material/area
- ✓ Equipments and instruments are sterilized after each use as per requirement & as per norms.
- ✓ Immediate reporting for cases of Hospital Acquired Infection to infection control team.

2. BMW related:

❖ Senior Nursing Officers to ensure

- ✓ Availability of colour coded bins & bags at point of waste generation.
- ✓ **Proper segregation of biomedical waste.**
- ✓ Availability of needle cutters for proper sharps management.
- ✓ Current format for Biomedical record register is followed which includes time of pick up and **weight of BMW waste (category wise)** at point of generation.
- ✓ Pictorial poster of spill management & new BMW posters are displayed at all areas. Posters can be collected from BMW team.
- ✓ Further housekeeping supervisor to monitor cleaning of their respective patient care areas and provide regular trainings to housekeeping staff.

3. Trainings:

❖ NABH team to coordinate with Senior Nursing Officers for trainings in wards/areas/department to various categories of hospital staff:

- ✓ Soft skill training

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- ✓ Documentation
 - ✓ Hand washing steps as per WHO guidelines
 - ✓ To ensure antisepsis before any procedure
 - ✓ Standard practices for PPE
 - ✓ Standard procedures for processing of equipments and instruments
 - ✓ Sharps disinfection protocol
 - ✓ Spill Management
 - ✓ Standard operating Procedures and protocols pertaining to Department.
 - ✓ Quality Policy & Objectives
- ❖ Senior Nursing Officers must place indent for required material (as mentioned above) to the concerned store, considering the consumption pattern and buffer stock. For any query related to BMW posters, Nursing Officers should approach BMW team.
- ❖ NABH team must provide regular trainings on the above mentioned topics; in coordination with Senior Nursing Officers and Housekeeping Supervisor.
